As the Beaumont Library now has capacity and social distancing guidelines in place, the tutoring program is online only. Tutors will need access to a device (computer, laptop, iPad) with a camera. Our Coordinators will assist in connecting families & tutors on an online platform (to be determined) and help sort out any issues encountered.

Being a tutor involves encouraging and explaining through various lessons/homework for the student to gain a better understanding of the concepts. This is a commitment to the student, to help them improve in their studies. We ask that tutors maintain a positive attitude and let the tutor coordinators know if encountering problems regarding academics, payment by families or behavior problems. It is important to be on time and focused on helping. All sessions are to be confidential, discussed only with the parent or tutor coordinators.

Fees of \$12/hr. (with an option for the Kindergarten to Grade 3 children for two sessions/week of 30 minutes each) are to be paid by the families to the tutor at the beginning of each month for the upcoming monthly sessions.

We ask that you contact your student's parent at least the evening prior should you be unable to make it to their booked session. It is the tutor's responsibility to maintain communication with the student's parents and the tutor coordinators.
